



Teacher's need to follow the guidance for marking children's work.

- Children's 'I can Targets' will be displayed clearly on each piece of work.
- At the end of the session adults working with the child will mark the targets:
Green for Go..... If target has been achieved.
Pink for Think..... If the target has not been understood.
- Children's work will also be stamped:
Encountered (opportunity presented but little interaction), Engaged (participated but needed a lot of adult interaction and guidance), Gaining Skills (some adult prompts and guidance) or Mastered (fully independent).
- Work should be marked with the child present in order to discuss areas of achievement and areas that need to be improved. A comment relating to 'next steps' can be added.
- It is good practise for children to be encouraged to review their work and self correct. This can then be marked as s/c.
